

## AWAY SUPPORTERS INFORMATION FOR VISITING WEMBLEY STADIUM

<b>SAFETY AND SECURITY</b>	<p>Please note there will be enhanced security searches in place for this match and all supporters need to be aware of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Supporters are encouraged to arrive at Wembley Stadium early to avoid delays in entry due to enhanced searching</li> <li>▪ Do not bring large bags / rucksacks. All bags will be searched regardless of size and no storage facilities are available within the stadium.</li> <li>▪ Be aware of prohibited items. A full list of prohibited items can be found here <a href="#">Wembley Stadium - Ground Regulations</a>.</li> <li>▪ Food and drink – Visitors are advised not to bring food and drink to the stadium as there will be sufficient provision inside for purchase.</li> <li>▪ Please note persistent standing is not permitted within the stadium bowl during the match. Wembley Stadium would kindly ask all supporters to abide by this rule and respond to the safety instructions from the stewarding team so that all guests can have an enjoyable experience.</li> </ul>
<b>MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS (PERMISSION REQUIRED)</b>	<p>Musical instruments can be permitted entry to the stadium as long as they are approved by Tottenham Hotspur and Wembley in advance of match day meeting guidelines.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Any supporters wishing to bring instruments to the match must first notify their club who in turn submit a request to Wembley. All non-official instruments will be refused entry. Please note no musical instruments will be permitted on level 5 of Wembley Stadium or hospitality boxes.</li> </ul> <p>Ahead of <b>seeking permission</b>, the club must collectively supply the following:</p> <p>The request <b>must</b> include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A photo showing the whole instrument</li> <li>• The actual size of the instrument (drums no larger than 55cm)</li> <li>• A full description of the instrument and noise</li> <li>• Submit an official request via: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><a href="mailto:mick.shuel@thefa.com">mick.shuel@thefa.com</a>;</li> <li><a href="mailto:Jason.eglash@thefa.com">Jason.eglash@thefa.com</a>;</li> <li><a href="mailto:Dean.smith@tottenhamhotspur.com">Dean.smith@tottenhamhotspur.com</a></li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p>If you arrive at Wembley Stadium and your instrument differs in any way from the photograph or description, it may be confiscated at the turnstiles and refused entry into the Stadium.</p> <p>Wembley Stadium reserves the right to remove any instruments if they are deemed to be causing an issue during the match.</p>

**FLAGS  
(PERMISSION NOT  
REQUIRED)**

Supporters may bring a flag into the ground **WITHOUT** permission from Wembley Stadium if:

- The flag is smaller than 250cm in size at the widest or longest point.
- It does not have an attached flag pole
- In the case of an attached flag pole, it is made from wood and plastic only and is no longer than 1 metre in length and 1cm in diameter.
- There is no advertising or commercial message on the flag
- It does not contain any abusive or defamatory message

\*\*Please note that flag poles made of metal are not permitted inside the stadium, no matter what size or length the flag / pole is.

If a supporter arrives at Wembley Stadium and their flag does not come under the above points, and they have not gained permission from Wembley Stadium, the flag may be confiscated at the turnstiles and refused entry.

**FLAGS  
(PERMISSION  
REQUIRED)**

Supporters will **NEED** permission from Wembley Stadium if any of the following applies:

- Flag is larger than 250cm in size at the widest or longest point
- The supporter wishes to have a static flag connected to seating (this is not possible for sold out games)
- Supporters wish to have a moving flag / banner over supporters' heads, pre match (see below guidelines)
- Flag has a pole connected that is over 1 metre in length and 1cm in diameter.

Ahead of **seeking permission**, the club must collectively supply the following:

The request **must** include:

- A photo showing the whole of the flag
- A photo showing any flag pole connected
- The actual size of the flag
- The location of where the flag is to be displayed (seat details or other)
- A valid, in date fire certificate, in English with the appropriate stamps of authority (*this is preferable but not mandatory*)

If you arrive at Wembley Stadium and your flag differs in any way from the photographed or described flag, your flag may be confiscated at the turnstiles and refused entry into the Stadium.

Wembley Stadium reserves the right to remove any flags if they are deemed to be causing an issue during the match.
